AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION FOR THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ELECTRIC ENERGY SUPPLY

Purpose:

In accordance with the Act Number 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, known as Administrative Standard Procedure Law for the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority publishes the Regulation for the General Terms and Conditions for the Electric Energy Supply.

This Regulation establishes special and general terms of interest to the user and to the Electric Power Authority; likewise, to set the requirements and conditions that a user is subject to, as well as the corresponding rights and obligations of the user and of the Electric Power Authority. The purpose of this Amendment to Section XI is to increase the top amounts of the administrative fines by alteration or undue use of the electric system, and to remit every evidence to the respective governing boards when evidence exist that certified electricians or engineers carried out an illegal installation or they altered a meter or the electric system.
